



The EYFS Framework explains how and what your child will be learning to support their healthy development.

Your child will be learning skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through seven areas of learning and development. Children should mostly develop the three prime areas first.

These are:

- Communication and language
- Physical development
- Personal, social and emotional development.

These prime areas are those most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning. As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in four specific areas.

These are:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design

These seven areas are used to plan your child's learning and activities. The professionals teaching and supporting your child will make sure that the activities are suited to your child's unique needs.

This is a little bit like a curriculum in primary and secondary schools, but it's suitable for very young children, and it's designed to be really flexible so that staff can follow your child's unique needs and interests.

Children in the EYFS learn by playing and exploring, being active, and through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outside.

AN ADMIN FEE OF £25 IS REQUIRED PER CHILD UPON REGISTRATION

You will be contacted the term before your child is due to start at Little Me Preschool to check that you will still require the sessions you have requested.

Government funding is for 15 hours per week and starts the term after the child's third birthday. Other charges apply, Snack £1.25 morning session or afternoon session, All day session £1.50. Tapestry (online learning journey) £2 per week.
